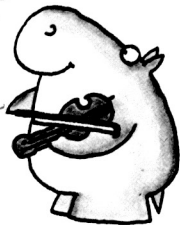

I've had a few minor problems with
 my unit but they are being taken care of.
 Sometimes the color cuts out leaving a B&W
 screen. If you push in the cartridge pretty
 hard, the color pops in again. It's been a
 nuisance at times but I can live with it
 for now. If it gets worse (and won't go back
 to color) I'll get it taken care of.

My other problem seems to be related to
 my interface, while using the programming
 cartridge sometimes the program would
 freeze on the screen with nothing functioning.
 If I pulled out the RS232 connector
 in socket #3 it would function again
 but you couldn't use the interface. Other
 times the interface would work fine. I



think there was some sort of short in the connector which my dealer said he'd have taken care of.
