As it is I can Input DAVA from the Keyboard under Basic control (or machine language) but Program
entry and editing must still be
done through the key pad. If I
can't get this to work I guess Bally Basic (OR some ofter language) could be Placed in RAM. A commented listing of Bally & would Be INVALUABLE AT

this point. Any Ideas where I could get one? With That into we could taylor that A bit And Put it in RAM. So - At this point I see the Remainder of the Expansion to be Mainly A software effort, which is where I could use some help, One of the most important changes I think, would be to get program storage out of Internal (graphics) memory. This would greatly increase the color capabilities when using Basico Another interesting possibility
opened by having the RAM Memory
Aunilable is the Ability to lond it
with data from Any of the GAME
CARTRIDGES (which was previously damped onto A cassette tape) and then switch this memory into the Bank normally Assigned to the Plug in EARTRIDE.

This is quite easy to do. At This point the Bally would perform

exactly as it you had pluged in the game carriage that the data came from. The end Result would be that you could have the entire liberary of Bally games on a couple of cassette tapes. Bally might not be too wild about this ; dea but I Assure you it would work, In the In the MEAN line in order to ease programing the Bolly, I use Another one of the microconputers I own, which has ASCIT Key board, to write Bally Basic programs on and Dump them on tape in a format compatable with the Bally. Doing it off line like 16;5
